TEACHING KIDS CHARACTER

Helping kids become **who they want to be.**

4C Club is a character program for **4th & 5th graders**. Over four weeks each semester, kids gather over a meal, step into a real-life story, and talk through one character trait — kindness, courage, respect, and more — then take home a keepsake card and one simple way to live it out.

WHY IT'S GOOD FOR YOUR STUDENTS

- A positive peer culture.** Kids catch each other doing good and celebrate it out loud — character becomes something they notice in each other, not just a rule.
- Character through story, not lectures.** Real stories and honest conversation, where the kids do the reflecting and reach their own conclusions.
- Kids leave encouraged and connected** — with stronger friendships and a clearer sense of the kind of person they want to become.
